

FAQs of FSM HACKATHON

Q. Who is eligible to take part in the event?

A. Students from engineering colleges specially from computer science background and students from B- schools can take part in this competition as this will be a great exposure for all of them.

Q. When is the deadline for submitting applications?

A. everyone would be notified about the deadlines soon on the website.

Q. What is the procedure for applying to participate?

A. You have to register on the registration link in teams of 5-6 members where one person would be the group leader. The registration link would be updated in the website as well as the mail that would be circulated around colleges.

Q. Is there a participation fee, and if so, how much is it?

A. There is no Participation fees in the competition.

Q. Is team registration allowed, and if yes, what is the maximum team size?

A. Yes, It is preferred that there is team participation and the maximum size of the team should be 5-6 members.

Q. What options are available for individuals without a team or a specific project idea?

A. Individuals should register in teams as it is mentioned in the website and in the guidelines and they have to work around the problem statements mentioned in the website and strictly adhere to them. Their project should be based out of these problem statements only.

Q. Upon acceptance, what items are participants required to bring to the event?

A. Accepted participants must bring their own laptops, chargers, and any specific hardware required for their prototype development. Additionally, personal identification and confirmation emails should be brought for smooth event registration.

Q. Are there any items or materials that participants should avoid bringing?

A. Participants should avoid bringing large equipment or materials that may disrupt the event environment. Items causing disturbance or hindering the workspace efficiency should be avoided to ensure a seamless and focused hackathon experience.

Q. How is the judging process structured during the FSM hackathon?

A. There will be Industry leaders with vast experience in data analytics field who would be judging this event and analysing the prototypes provided by the contestants according to the problem statement and evaluating them on the application and feasibility of their models.
